The Precious Value of Children

Last weekend was very encouraging for those who attended the Lads to Leaders (L2L) meeting in Orlando. SFA had seven children participating (see next page). Events like this remind us of the value God places on children. A glimpse into this value can be seen from Psalm 127:3-5, and applications can be made to the church, the family of God (1 Tim. 3:15).

First, children are a blessing. "Behold, children are a heritage from the LORD, The fruit of the womb is a reward" (Ps. 127:3). The parallelism with "heritage [gift, NAS95]" and "reward" shows that children are a reward, not according to a duty-bound, forced demand but according to their cooperative free-will, which implies proper training (Eph. 6:1-4). While true in the physical family, the church is also blessed by God with scripturally trained children in its assemblies, especially when those young people are also in God's book of life (Phil. 4:3). Thank you, parents and children, who follow God's plan (Col. 3:20-21). You are a blessing!

Second, children are strength. "Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, So are the children of one's youth" (Ps. 127:4). In an era where each village or city had to defend itself against enemies, the more "arrows in ... hand," the greater a stand could be taken. "Children of one's youth" refers to children born while parents are young. These children will be old enough to provide strength and security when the parents are old (which illustrates another aspect of why the prodigal son's leaving his father was tragic, Lk. 15:11-13). While children provide strength to the physical family, they also make the local church stronger by their good example and encouragement (Mt. 18:3-4; 1 Tim. 4:12). Thank you, children, for the strength you contribute to this congregation!

Third, children bring happiness. "Happy is the man who has his quiver full of them; They shall not be ashamed, But shall speak with their enemies in the

gate" (Ps. 127:5). With a "quiver full" of children, the happiness is twofold: (1) the father would not be ashamed; and (2) the father would be defended. The plurals "they ... their" (singulars in ESV) still speak of the father but in general terms to include all fathers. "Enemies in the gate" refer to adversaries in a legal [Continued on page 3]

Teaching students to do "Bible things in Bible ways"

From the L2L website: Since our foundation in 1968, the mission of Lads to Leaders/Leaderettes (L2L) has been to develop youth into Christian leaders. From a group of eight boys in that first year to more than 20,000 today, our mission has remained the same.

L2L is the oldest and largest leadership training program used by the churches of Christ today. It is a tool churches of Christ can use to help prepare their youth and adults for service in the Kingdom of God and help develop their overall leadership potential. L2L is more than just attending a youth rally or participating in a Bible Bowl. We offer a variety of Bible-based class materials and events for preschoolers through adults.

The goal of L2L is to provide churches of Christ with effective, year-round leadership training tools that can be adapted to individual congregational needs and help local congregations instill the Word of God into youth and adults to ensure they stand firm in the faith.

SFA's Involvement 2024

Bible Bowl, for the first time in several years, SFA had a Bible Bowl team consisting of **Landan**, **Peyton**, **Hannah**, and **June**. The rules require the team to compete at the level of the oldest child on the team. Thus, middle-schoolers, **Hannah** and **June**, competed against high-schoolers ... and they held their own! Great job, team!

Special Recognition: Landan received recognition for being awarded the Jack Zorn Bible scholarship for Faulkner University. He was one of only two who received such recognition in Orlando. Great job, **Landan!**

Bible Reading is for children K-2. Participants, grouped in rooms according to gender, read a passage of Scripture and are critiqued on their reading ability, eye contact, proper inflection, etc. This definitely helps them deal with "stage fright" in all areas of life. **Hailee** and **Maddox** participated in this.

Art Says It contains several categories of art where participants can express the "I Am Not Ashamed" theme through drawings, photographs, scrapbooks, etc. **Maddox** participated. **Hannah** placed third in drawing. **June** was a finalist in drawing and placed third in posters.

Songs of Praise is song leading for girls in assemblies where only females are present (except for nursing baby boys and mom-dependent male toddlers). In the K-2 category (which is not judged), **Hailee** participated. **June** placed third in her very large age-group.

Song Leading is for boys. **Peyton** participated in this.

Winner's Circle Song Leading is for boys who in previous years placed first in their age group. **Landan**, who placed first last year in eleventh grade, participated in the 10th – 12th grade winner's circle bracket.

Girls Speech is done in assemblies where only females are present (with the exception of boy babies and toddlers, if necessitated). **Hannah** participated. **June** placed third in her very large age-group.

Boys Speech are sermons that are 4-6 minutes in length. **Landan** and **Peyton** participated in this, and if it weren't for nervousness that cut his lesson way short, one of these young men may have placed in the top three.

Keepers is a year-around program for girls where they learn to become adept at filling their scriptural role, develop confidence, and leadership skills. **Hannah** and **June** participated in this.
