"ABOUNDING MORE AND MORE"

Throughout Paul's first letter to the Thessalonians, he commended them for their faith, love, and hope (1 Thes. 1:3), for their receiving God's word despite persecution (1 Thes. 1:2; 2:13-16), for their being examples by turning from idolatry to God (1 Thes. 1:7-10), and for their encouraging faith (1 Thes. 3:5-8). Yet, as Paul began to conclude this letter, he encouraged them to "abound more and more, just as you received from us how you ought to walk and to please God" (1 Thes. 4:1). This tells us that even though we may have commendable faith, we can never say, "I've arrived." Each of us must continue to grow, or "abound more and more," in our Christian walk! Below are three necessities for doing this.

First, we must examine ourselves to make sure our faith would be commended by God. Paul wrote, "Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?" (2 Cor. 13:5). A person who claims to be a Christian can live such a worldly life that it leaves people wondering whether that person was ever truly converted to Christ. While it is true that some, like Demas, can forsake the faith, "having loved this present world" (2 Tim. 2:10), others may have just went through the motions of being baptized but were never truly "circumcised" in heart (Col. 2:11-13 cf. Rom. 2:28-29). We cannot "abound more and more" if we were not faithful to begin with! Have we been truly converted?

Second, we must continue studying God's word. The God-breathed formula is still true: "faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God" (Rom. 10:17). Our faith can never outrun our knowledge of God! This is why studying God's word is so important, no matter how old we are or how long we have been Christians (2 Tim. 2:15). This is also why attending church services is so important. There is no better way to "stir up love and good works" than by assembling together to worship God and to study His word, mutually encouraging one another from Bible precepts (Heb. 10:24-25 cf. Acts 2:46; 5:42). Peter's last exhortation was to "grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ" (2 Pet. 3:18). Do we hunger and thirst for God's word?

Third, we must continue and increase our putting God's word into action. James put it plainly: "be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves ... a doer of the work ... will be blessed in what he does" (Jas. 1:22-25). The only person who will reach heaven is the one who "does the will of My [Jesus'] Father in heaven" (Mt. 7:21). This is not only true for those outside of Christ but also for those in Christ (Lk. 12:47-48). We will be judged by how we used God's blessings (Mt. 25:14-30). The answer to Jesus' question still holds true: "But why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do the things which I say?" (Lk. 6:46). Are we letting our light shine so others may glorify God?

May each of us bring glory to God by constantly examining and improving our service to God, studying His word, and doing His word! ♥ Brian

Amen" (Ephesians 3:14-21). "For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh. ³² This is a great mystery, but I speak concerning Christ and the church. ³³ Nevertheless let each one of you in particular so love his own wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband" (Ephesians 5:31-33). "I write so that you may know how you ought to conduct yourself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth" (1 Timothy 3:15).

Preparation Is Important!

I remember the days as a single mom without a car. Each morning I would have to catch the city bus to drop off my kids to day care before heading to work. Nightly preparations determined if I would get to work on time the next day. If I was unprepared, I had to scurry to get myself and the kids to the bus stop on time. Most of the times the bus would whiz by as I was walking down the road.

For Christians the return of the Lord is not like the bus I had to catch. I knew exactly what time the bus was going to be at the stop. However, the return of the Lord is unknown. (2 Peter 3:10 "But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night.") For me to make it to the bus stop on time, I had to prepare in advance. Christians must prepare right now for the Day of Judgement. Prepare while the blood is still running warm in our veins, while we have health, strength, and sound mind. We cannot scramble around at the last minute trying to prepare ourselves. (Matthew 25:13 says, "Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh.") We don't want to be like the foolish virgins in Matthew 25:1-13. They were told in verse 12, "Verily I say unto you, I know you not."

Youth Section

Lessons from I Timothy

"Bodily Exercise Profits a Little" (I Timothy 4)

Paul shared a truth about the church with Timothy that some would leave the faith. As Jesus shared in the Parable of the Soils, some will spring up for a season but when the heat is turned up, they will wither. Timothy was to be watchful for these things, and "if you instruct the brethren in these things, you will be a good minister" (4:6). There is a benefit to carefully following the sound doctrine. He then makes a comparison, "bodily exercise profits a little, but godliness is profitable for all things, having promise of the life that now is and of that which is to come" (4:8). To function in this world we need a body that is in some manner of physical health. We know that over time the body will wear out. Eventually the healthiest and most fit physical specimen will deteriorate. Compared to the one who takes his spiritual workout seriously, it has benefits in the here and now, and Paul says in the life to come. You will never be disappointed in the spiritual gains that come from a life of Bible study, prayer, and good works in service for the Lord. -VD
