"Hades" Is Not "Hell"

While studying the Book of Revelation, particularly the opening of the fourth seal, where John writes, "I looked, and behold, a pale horse. And the name of him who sat on it was Death, and Hades followed with him" (Rev. 6:8), it was again realized the KJV makes no distinction here (or anywhere) between "Hades" and "Hell," yet there is a significant difference in the meaning of these words. Since "Hades" (*hades*, $\ddot{a}\delta\eta\varsigma$) is actually a transliteration, the word was likely not in use in 1611 when the KJV was first translated.

The eternal "hell" is from a different Greek word, *gehenna* (γέεννα), which is so named after "the city dump of Jerusalem," and serves as a "picture of the final place of judgement for the wicked" (Rogers and Rogers, *The New Linguistic and Exegetical Key to the Greek New Testament*, 11). The KJV, unfortunately, translates both *hades* and *ghenenna* with the word "hell." KJV users should know and note that the following verses (also listed below) more accurately read "Hades" in the more-up-to-date translations (Mt. 11:23; 16:18; Lk. 10:15; 16:23; Acts 2:27, 31; Rev. 1:18; 6:8; 20:13-14). It does make a difference!

"Hades" is from *hades* ($\[act]\delta\eta\varsigma$) and refers to the world of departed spirits; death (Mt. 11:23; 16:18; Lk. 10:15; 16:23; Acts 2:27, 31; Rev. 1:18; 6:8; 20:13-14). Hades is the temporary "holding place" of all human souls/spirits that have separated by death from their physical human bodies (Jas. 2:26). It can refer to the place of all departed spirits, where even Jesus' spirit went for three days between His death and resurrection (Acts 2:27, 31). It can also refer to the place of departed wicked spirits (Lk. 16:23; Rev. 20:13-14).

Luke 16:19-31 gives a more detailed description of Hades. From that passage, we learn at least four important truths about Hades. First, it has two compartments, "Abraham's bosom" (Lk. 16:22), also called "Paradise" (Lk. 23:43 cf. Acts 2:31), and a place of torment (Lk. 16:23-24, 28). Second, there is a "gulf [chasm, ESV]" that makes passing from one compartment to another impossible (Lk. 16:26). Third, it is a place for God to keep departed souls/spirits until judgment day (cf. Eccl. 12:7; Jn. 5:28-29). Since people's influence can live long after their deaths (cf. Abel [Heb. 11:4]; Jeroboam [2 Kgs. 17:20-23]), final judgement cannot be just until this world has run its course. Fourth, at the end of time, when Jesus comes the "second time" (Heb. 9:27-28), Hades will give up the departed souls/spirits in it to be judged by God (2 Cor. 5:10). Then, Hades will be eternally destroyed, for its purpose will have been fulfilled (Rev. 20:11-15).

Matthew 11:23 — And you, Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to **Hades**; for if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day.

Matthew 16:18 – And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of **Hades** shall not prevail against it.

Luke 10:15 – And you, Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to Hades.

Luke 16:23 – And being in torments in **Hades**, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.

Acts 2:27, 31 — For You will not leave my soul in **Hades**, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption. ... he, foreseeing this, spoke concerning the resurrection of the Christ, that His soul was not left in **Hades**, nor did His flesh see corruption.

Revelation 1:18 – I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of **Hades** and of Death.

Revelation 6:8 – So I looked, and behold, a pale horse. And the name of him who sat on it was Death, and **Hades** followed with him.

Revelation 20:13-14 — The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and **Hades** delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works. Then Death and **Hades** were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.



YOUTH SECTION V. Daugherty Lessons from II Timothy

<u>On your feet Soldier (II Timothy 1:6-12)</u> It seems like Paul's son in the faith Timothy was

not always the most courageous of young men. So Paul, as a good father figure, sought to encourage Timothy in his work. He said, "I remind you to stir up the gift of God which is in you" (v. 6). Timothy had a special measure of the Spirit given to him, yet seemed timid to exercise that gift. You may not have the same spiritual gifts Timothy had, but you have a unique set of skills given to you by God. Do not waste those gifts but rather use them! "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind" (v. 7). Timothy's courage may have been shaken because of the current situation Paul was in; Paul was bound in chains. Timothy may have supposed because the enemy has Paul locked up maybe the cause of Christ was not the best path to take. Wrong, Paul told Timothy not to be "ashamed of the testimony of our Lord", nor of "me His prisoner, but share with me in the sufferings for the gospel" (v. 8). Paul said though he was in chains, they could not take away his position before God. "for I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that day" (v. 12). If you are feeling down or discouraged, Paul says "ON YOUR FEET SOLDIER"!
