MISSION FIELDS

The Prayer of Jabez

The Bible records over 650 prayers. Each one teaches us the importance of drawing closer to God. Prayer is how we stay connected to God (Ephesians 3:14-21). When we don't know what to pray for, the Holy Spirit intercedes (Romans 8:26). Many blessings befall us when we pray to God. We give God our worries (1 Peter. 5:7), and God gives us his peace (Philippians 4:6-7). The prayer of Jabez only contains 32 words. Small in words, but powerful in point. The Bible records, "Now Jabez was more honorable than his brothers, and his mother called his name Jabez, saying, Because I bore him in pain. And Jabez called on God of Israel saying, Oh, that you would bless me indeed, and enlarge my territory, that your hand would be with me, and that you would keep me from evil, that I may cause pain. So God granted him what he requested." (1Chronicles 4:9-10). All that we know of Jabez is contained in these two verses. These two verses are contained within the context of genealogy. Finding a prayer amid the genealogical tables is much akin to; finding a beautiful flower in the desert. A treasure hid in the sand. A star peeping through the dark storm clouds of the night. With some great Bible characters, we have information about each part of their lives. Jabez is only known by his prayer to God. The Bible does not tell us how religious Jabez was, but what we know of him and his prayer, shows us that he knew the God of Heaven could grant him what he was requesting.

It Was A Prayer With A Purpose

When we offer our prayers up to God they have to be with a purpose. Jabez says, "Oh that you would bless me indeed." God wants to bless us greatly. This is a request for spiritual benefits, "Bless me indeed." It is easy to get caught up in physical blessings. We often pray for a new job, a new home, and a new car. Jesus would say "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness and all these things shall be added unto you." (Matthew. 6:33). When we fix our eyes on Heaven, God will give us everything in between Earth and Heaven. Purpose is the reason for which something is done or created or for which something exists. Our prayers have to be purposed filled, with sound reason, and with Heaven on our minds.

It Was A Prayer For Prosperity

Jabez asks of God, "And enlarge my coast." As stated above there is nothing wrong with asking God for "possessions." We just have to make sure we are seeking him first. Jabez was ambitious, but he also had the right attitude. Paul records, "Therefore if there is any encouragement in Christ, if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and compassion. Make my joy complete by being of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in Spirit, intent on one purpose. Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves." (Philippians. 2:1-3). God is very welcoming to ambition, but we cannot allow that to become selfish ambition.

It Was A Prayer For Power

Jabez would say, "That your hand would be with me." As we go through this life, we will need to help of God with us. Our culture has created this notion that you somehow don't need God. You can live without God, and be okay in his eyes. Jabez knew that on his own he could not succeed. Before Peter encourages us to give our worries to God, he speaks about humility. The Bible records, "Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you at the proper time." (1 Peter. 5:6). James would say, "Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord, and he will exalt you." God expects us to be humble. Whether it be the enlargement of his border or a struggle against the evil one, Jabez knew that he needed God with him.

It Was A Prayer For Protection

The Bible records, "And that you would keep me from evil." Jabez needed what we continue to need today. The victory over evil. One of the greatest tools of the Devil is his desire to get us not to turn to God. The Devil wants us to fear the things of this world. God has, and will always protect us. If we allow him to. The Devil has been defeated. The devil no longer has any power over God's children. Paul records, "Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom of God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death. O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labor is not in vain in the Lord." (1 Corinthians 15:24-26; 55-58). God will protect us from sin, death, and Satan. If we put our lives in his hands.

It Was A Prayer For A Painless Life

Jabezasks, "That may not cause pain." Should Jabez be overrun with sin, that would cause him grief, sorrow, and pain. God can help us to avoid these things in our lives. That is not to say we will not suffer (2 Timothy, 3:12; 1 Peter 4:16). All suffering is not punishment, Godhas to test us and prove us as well (Deuteronomy 8:2; Hebrews 12:6). The Answer To His Prayer

The Bible records the answer, "And God granted him that which he requested." How pleased God must have been with Jabez, and his prayer. God will bless us when we honor him. John would say, "This is the confidence we have approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us whatever we ask we know that we have what we asked of him." (1John. 5:14-15). Faithfulness and prayer are as well pleasing to God. Our prayers have to be Christ-centered and Heaven-bound. God will grant us "according to his will." May the example of Jabez, be a model for us to follow as we offer our prayers up to our God.


