FOUR THINGS JESUS LEFT THE CHURCH

Within the ministry of Jesus, we see the many tasks he had to fulfill. As we open the book of Acts, Luke records Jesus Christ's ascension back into Heaven (Acts. 1:10-11). Our Lord left many tasks for us to fulfill on this side of eternity. He left us great work to do. Matthew records, "And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world." (Matthew. 28:18-20).

JESUS LEFT US AN UNFINISHED TASK

The work of Christ is now the work of Christ's people. Luke records, "Of all that Jesus began both to do and teach." (Acts. 1:1). When Christians say "they don't have anything to do" that is not a statement of being misinformed. The Gospel of Jesus Christ does not just save us from sin, it changes the way we live. If we are the image of Christ and we follow his example (1 Peter. 2:21), then there is much work for us to do. Luke says in his book, "For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost." (Luke. 19:10). Mark records, "And he said to them, go into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature. He who believes and is baptized shall be saved; but he does not believe will be condemned." (Mark. 16:15-16).

We will never bring all the world into Christ until we bring Christ into all the world. We will have not faith in the mission before us unless we have faith in the master behind us. We will never get others to obey the great commands until we obey the great commission. We cannot expect the world to react to the word until we act on it. We will never get excited over sowing the seed until we get excited over seeing the need. We can't make Christ mean anything to others until we make him mean everything to us. We will never convert others when we have no convictions. We will never consider the lost until we consider the cost. We are not going to bring in the sheaves until we roll up ourselves. Christ left us an unfinished task and it's time we get to work.

JESUS LEFT US AN UNCHANGEABLE MESSAGE

We do not have to worry about preaching the truth only to find the truth has changed. We all can take great comfort in knowing the Bible does not change. If an individual is not willing to change they will not like what the Bible has to say. Those of us who love God and truth, again take comfort that God in knowing that his word will not change.

The author of truth is not going to change, "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, today, and forever." (Hebrews. 13:8). The message itself is not going to change, "Beloved, when I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints." (Jude. 3). The benefits of truth are not going to change, "And you shall know the truth, and truth shall make you free." (John. 8:32). The power of truth will not change, "For I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek." (Romans. 1:16). The specifies of the truth will not change, "There is one body and one spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one Faith, one Baptism, one God and father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all." (Ephesians. 4:4-6).

JESUS LEFT US AN UNLIMITED POWER

Our power is provided for us by God. The power of the gospel is still an unlimited power (Romans. 1:16). Paul would write to Corinth, "For the preaching of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, by to us who are being saved it is the power of God." (1 Corinthians. 1:18). When we read of those who stood behind God, God gave them the power and strength to fight off whatever the difficulty was. David did not defeat Goliath by his strength, he was able to succeed because of God (1 Samuel. 17). Paul was not about to endure his thorn in the flesh himself, God gave him the strength to continue (2 Corinthians. 12:6-8).

Paul would encourage Timothy, "For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and love, and of a sound mind." (2 Timothy. 1:7). In Ephesians 1, Paul shows those brethren the same power Jesus used in raising himself from the dead, is the same power that is within us today (Ephesians. 1:18-120).

JESUS LEFT US UNFAILING PROMISES

God promises us his closeness. Throughout the Bible, God gives assurances to those who faithfully believed in him and trusted in him. God promised Joshua after the death of Moses that he would always be with him. Joshua records the encounter (Joshua. 1:1-4). Our key thought is found after these verses, "There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, not forsake thee." (Joshua. 1:5). God will never make a promise that he does not keep. He is a promise keeper. Abraham that he would have a son. Paul records of Abraham, "Who against hope believe in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be. And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able to also to perform." (Romans. 4:18; 21).

God promises his salvation for those who are scripturally baptized into his son (Mark. 16:15-16). He promised us a way for our prayers to be heard by the father (John. 14:13). He promised that he would come and take us home with him (John. 14:1-3). Satan will promise that which he cannot deliver. A promise is an unpaid debt. Christ never made a promise that was too good to be true.

CONCLUSION

As Christians, we have a great responsibility that Jesus Christ has given to us. Are we going to answer the call? God is present with us (Hebrews. 13:5). God will protect us (Genesis. 15:1). God will empower us to stay the course (Isaiah. 41:10; 2 Timothy 4:6-8). Jesus Christ has called you to carry out the task. Let's get to work!
