Israel's Place in God's Plan Salvation Is God's Choice (Part 1)

Why is today's Israel hated so much by the world? Various possibilities exist. Among the top reasons are: (1) there is a misunderstanding of Old Testament Israel and the nation today that calls itself "Israel;" and (2) the anti-biblical world often groups Jews and Christians together by virtue of their being a major focus in the Bible, and with the Marxist philosophy of oppression permeating more and more of American culture, anything connecting with the Bible is seen as the "oppressor" that needs to be eliminated. One of the richest sections in the New Testament that shows Israel's place in God's plan is Romans 9–11. This article will deal with the major teaching in Romans 9 that shows God's place for Israel has already been determined by the historical track-record of God, showing that He alone gets to choose how mankind will be saved.

Israel Failed to Accept the Gospel

Paul declared his "countrymen according to the flesh [Israel]" were spiritually lost (Rom. 9:1-2). Paul was so emotionally concerned about their damnation that if it were possible, he would sacrifice himself (as "accursed") for them to be saved (Rom. 9:3). Israel's lost condition was even more tragic because they had special blessings that should have assured their compliance to the Gospel when it came (Rom. 9:4-5 cf. Lk. 12:47-48). However, in a key passage to this discussion, Paul wrote, "For they are not all Israel who are of Israel, nor are they all children because they are the seed of Abraham" (Rom. 9:6-7 cf. Rom. 2:28-29; Gal. 5:6). Israel in Paul's day thought their very lineage made them "once God's people, always God's people," but even John the Baptist pointed out there is more to being God's people than physical bloodline, for "God is able to raise up children to Abraham from these stones" (Mt. 3:7-10).

God Has Always Chosen the Path of Salvation

Contrary to the first century Jewish idea that because they were specially chosen to be God's people they should always remain God's special people, Paul reminded them that salvation has always been God's choice. Paul detailed five avenues through which God exercised His sovereign right to chose salvation.

First, God's choice was proven by Isaac (Rom. 9:6-9). The promise of God did not fail, but Israel did! The promise was given first (Gen. 12:3); the law was added later (Gal. 3:19); and then the law was fulfilled and taken out of the way by Christ (Mt. 5:17; Rom. 8:3-4; Eph. 2:13-17; Col. 2:13-16). The promise was fulfilled in the Gospel (Gal. 3:16, 21-29). All Israelites are not children of the promise. To prove that a person is a physical decedent of Abraham proves absolutely nothing concerning salvation—the promise was through Isaac! Abraham was the father of several children (Gen. 16:4, 11; 25:1-2). Paul distinguished those children into two groups: (1) "of the flesh" were those born to Abraham naturally, but these had nothing to do with the fulfillment of the promise; and (2) "of the promise" were those born by eternal purpose and promise—these are Abraham's link to the seed line in Christ Jesus (Gal. 3:16). God chose to limit His promise through Isaac. Who can object?

Second, God's choice was proven by Jacob (Rom. 9:10-13). Isaac had two sons of which a choice had to be made concerning the seed. The choice had nothing to do with those two sons' personal salvation, but

this example was used to illustrate the principle of God's right to choose. Furthermore, the choice had nothing to do with their "worth" or birth right (Rom. 9:11). God chose Jacob (cf. Gen. 25:23). "Jacob I have loved ... Esau I have hated" has to do with selection of the promised seed rather than individual likeness. "Love / hate" means to favor one more than the other (Mt. 10:37-38). The choice concerns itself with the nations that came from the two sons and the role that each would play in the promise. God chose to limit His promise to Jacob. Who can object? *[To be continued]*
