## LORD, TEACH US TO PRAY



Luke 11:1-13 *Vince Daugherty* 

If I am being honest with myself, I can let the Christian discipline and blessing of prayer slip in my daily habits. I get going with the morning hustle and bustle, and I forgot to start my day off in prayer. I race to work, listen to a podcast, radio, or music, and forget to pray. I sit down to a meal and forget to thank God for His blessings. I pick kids up from school and don't take the time to share our day with the Lord in prayer. I go about chores at home, soccer practice with the boys, and forget to stop and spend time with my Lord in prayer. I finish my day and when my head hits the pillow I can be out like a light, and oh I forgot to pray... all day. To forget about prayer an entire day is (1) a shame, we are connected to the omnipotent ruler of the universe who makes time for me; (2) it is ungrateful to the sustainer of the entire cosmos, all the way down to little insignificant me; and (3) a wasted opportunity to think about others and intercede on their behalf. Maybe you are like me, being forgetful of the great blessing, prayer. If so, like the disciples of the first century, we need to ask the Lord, "Teach us to pray" (Luke 11:1).

# A Model for Prayer

Jesus blessed His disciples, then as now, with a model, or blueprint, for our prayers. If we do not know where to begin in our prayers, we ought to start with His model. He said, "When you pray, say... And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one" (Luke 11:2-4). First, when we pray, we must acknowledge and give honor to our heavenly Father. "Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name." Second, we ought to pray for God's will to be done. He is the Creator and Sustainer of all life, so we acknowledge that His way is best and pray for things to be done as He would approve. "Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven." Some people get a little nervous about the phrase, "Your kingdom come," since the kingdom has already been inaugurated (Acts 1; 2). However, His will is not done universally and His kingdom is not come to all men so to pray that petition is not wrong. Next, God daily blesses us with the things we need. It is good to acknowledge, thank, and continue to ask for our daily necessities. "Give us day by day our daily bread." Next, our ability to communicate with God is that we have been made holy by the blood of Jesus, We daily need to acknowledge that it is God who forgives our sins and continues to forgive our sins, as we also forgive others. "And forgive us of our sins, For we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us." Finally, we ask for God's protection and care as we learn to avoid sin and steer clear of temptation. "And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one" (Luke 112-4). When we first begin, we may memorize this model prayer. As we become comfortable in the discipline to see the prayer as a model, or a blueprint, we can make our prayers more personalized.

# WE DO NOT INCONVENIENCE GOD

We all have that one friend who contacts us at crazy times. It is good to set boundaries with people because we have limitations. However, friends can sometimes override boundaries because of our love for that friend. Even though it is inconvenient, we will take the call/text in the middle of the night. We will go the extra mile, and we will make a special effort, even though it is a grind on us! When we pray, we pray to God. We never inconvenience God in your prayers. He never sleeps. He never gets tired of listening. He is never tied up with other responsibilities. Even the Son, "ever lives to make intercession for us" (Heb. 7:25) in heaven on our behalf to the Father. When friends and family cannot meet our needs, the Lord is open 24/7 365. He will never fail us. His ear is always open to our needs at any hour of the day.

# KEEP ON Asking, SEEKING, & KNOCKING



Jesus said when we pray, we must be persistent. When we are in need, we need to ask. We are connected to the God who can help and who desires to help us in our needs. He knows what we need before we ask. The burden is not too great for Him. We often have decisions in our lives that we cannot know what the right answer is. The answer is to seek God's wisdom in our prayers. "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, Who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him" (James 1:5). When we pray, God answers in three ways: Yes, No, or Not yet. When we pray, we need to continue to listen/look for God's answers. If we give up after our first attempt, we cannot know if perhaps God desires for us to wait on His timing. Or, maybe He is saying no, and waiting on us to change our prayer to bring our desires more into His alignment. "You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss" (James 4:3). When we do not immediately receive a yes answer from God, we ought to immediately come back to prayer to see if maybe we are the ones who need to change. Jesus says if we, being dumb, ignorant, and evil, know how to give good gifts to our children when they ask, "how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!" (Luke 11:13).

## Conclusion

Pray without ceasing. Start off terrible, stumbling your way in the dark. Continue to study the Scriptures to see how Jesus and others prayed. Continue to ask God for wisdom. Seek His will for you and your life (and your prayer life). I always wonder about Daniel. He set an example of daily, continual prayer. He also was privileged to see great things from God's mind. God is ready to listen, able to respond, and desirous to do so. We have to talk to God and communicate. We need to learn to pray.

- Incline your ear to wisdom
- Apply your heart to understanding
  - cry out for discernment
- lift up your voice for understanding
  - seek her as silver
- search for her as hidden treasure

Then you will understand the fear of the Lord, And find the knowledge of God. (Prov. 2:1-4)

If you want to learn something new, put your entire being into it. Do not be halfway. If you do not know something raise your hand, and keep on asking questions until you do understand it. "Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might" (Ecc. 9:10). There are so many things to learn under the sun, more than can ever be learned. Whatever you find in your mind to learn, be totally engaged and you will learn more, and more faster than those who are not. Most of all, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding" (Prov. 3:5).


