7 Habits of Highly Effective Christians

Recently I listened to an excellent sermon by my father, Bruce Daugherty, in which he took a wordplay on the book, *Seven Habits of Highly Effective People*, by Steven Covey. Though Mr. Covey has passed away and his book was written over thirty years ago, it is still a top-selling book. My father's sermon title was "7 Habits of Highly Effective Christians." The sermon was good, but what made it excellent was the image stacking he employed throughout. With each habit, paint for yourself a mental picture, then stack those pictures on top of each other to aid memorization.

- **1. Opening a Bible:** "Be diligent [Study, KJV] to present yourselves to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (II Tim. 2:15). I cannot know the will of God if I do not feed upon His word.
- 2. Folding Hands: "Pray without ceasing" (I Thess. 5:17).
- **3. Catching Little Foxes:** "Catch us the foxes, The little foxes that spoil the vines, For our vines have tender grapes" (Song. 2:15). We may think sin looks cute and innocent, like a little fox. But sin like that little fox is wild. It will spoil the fruit of righteousness before our God and Father.
- **4. Sharing French Fries:** "But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased" (Heb. 13:16). Make it a habit of putting others before self. It may look like a father's allowing his sons to take the last French fry.
- **5.** Cultivating Fruit: "the fruit of the Spirit is—love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control." (Gal. 5:22,23). Fewer and fewer people are going into vocations of farming and gardening, but Christians should have a spiritual green thumb when it comes to cultivating the fruit of the Spirit.
- **6. Grabbing a Towel and Bowl:** "Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was going to God, rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself. After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with a towel with which He was girded" (John 13:3-5). My God and Savior Jesus Christ took upon the role of a servant. What task do I think I am too good for?
- **7.** Wearing a Wedding Ring: Wearing a Wedding Ring: "Wives submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord... Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her" (Eph. 5:22,25). In a world that has made divorce easy, we ought to be the model. Faithful to Christ until death is what we promised. Just like those couples who say "I do" in marriage.

Stack the images, memorize the verses, and practice the behaviors. That is how a habit is formed. The kingdom and South Florida Ave. need more highly effective Christians.



Instructions from a Father (Part 5) How to Lef-A-R-N: N is for No Distractions

Once when Jesus came to town, He entered the house of Mary and Martha. As any good hosts would do, they wanted to prepare the place for their guest. However, when Jesus got there, Mary stopped what she was doing and gave her complete attention to Jesus. "But Martha was distracted with much serving" (Luke 10:40). When she complained to Jesus that her sister was not helping, Jesus said to her, "you are worried and troubled about many things" (Luke 10:41). Mary was not going to let one second be wasted from being able to be with Jesus. It is good to learn to get rid of any distractions. Psalm 119:15 reads, "I will meditate on your precepts and fix my eyes on your ways." Think about our eyes. When there is only one place to focus them, and it is on what we are learning, we have eliminated distractions. Turn off the TV, video games, phones, and tablets. If we want to learn something, we must give 100% dedication to what it is we are wanting to learn. Set a timer and give ourselves to whatever it is for 5, 10, or 15 minutes. After the timer goes off, take a break, relax and do it again. We will find yourself learning how to learn without distractions. "Let your eyes look directly forward, and your gaze be straight before you" (Prov. 4:25). VD
